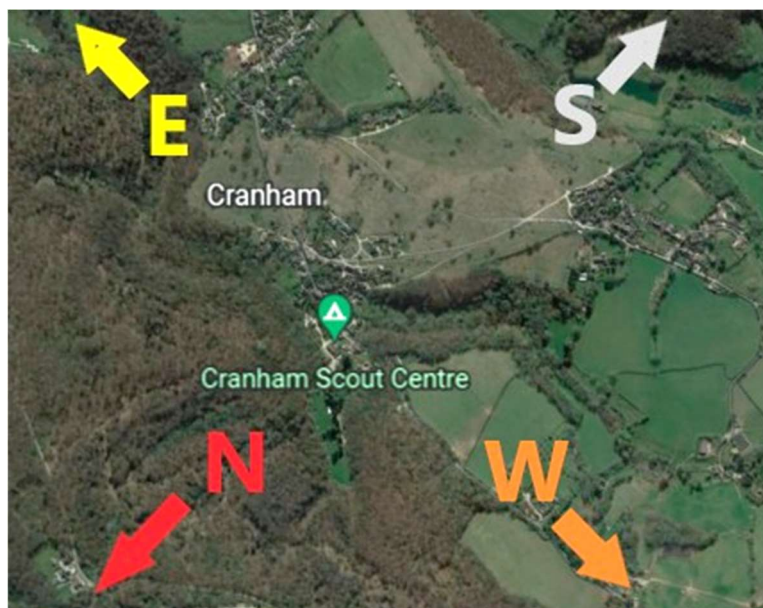



## Cranham Village Quiz Walk 2022

To complete this quiz, you will need a pen/pencil & stacks of enthusiasm.  
 A simple compass may help – if not take a note of your bearings and the direction of the common and Buckholt Wood before leaving.



*Anything in **Bold font** is an instruction and will help you complete the Quiz.*

<b>Start in the main car park by the toilet block and follow the road left.</b>	
1. What are the woods called surrounding Cranham Scout Centre?	<b>Buckholt and Rough Park Woods</b>
2. What is the name of the house by the stream?	<b>Winding Waters</b>
<b>Turn Left out of the Scout Centre and walk up the hill.</b>	
3. What birds can you find at Rose Cottage?	<b>Owls</b>
4. What is the speed limit up the hill?	<b>30 MPH</b>
5. What is the name of the bus stop?	<b>Cranham The Pound</b>
6. How many steps are there leading to the main entrance at the Village Hall?	<b>8</b>
7. When was the building adopted by the people as the Village Hall?	<b>1977</b>
8. What also happened in this year?	<b>Silver Jubilee</b>
<b>Continue walking up the road in a West direction</b>	
9. What are the two numbers on the yellow fire hydrant sign?	<b>90 / 3</b>
	
10. From Tanglewood house, how many telegraph poles are there on the same side of the road as the house?	<b>3 Telegraph poles</b>
11. What animal is written on the telegraph pole outside Tanglewood house?	<b>Cobra</b>
12. What is the name of the last house on the left?	<b>Dove Cote</b>
13. Continue along the road. Who made the speed limit sign and what is the phone number?	<b>Ringway 01934421400</b>
<b>At the junction you should see a black signpost and bench. PLEASE BE CAREFUL WHEN CROSSING.</b>	

14. What does the arrow facing the way you have just come from say?	<b>Scout HQ, Village Hall, Black Horse</b>
<b>Follow the arrow to the Cricket Ground along the road, pass one speed limit sign and sit on the bench.</b>	
15. What is written on the bench?	<b>Cranham</b>
<b>Just before the bench is a footpath follow this all the way to the top of the hill where you will find another bench.</b>	
16. Who is the bench in memory of?	<b>Heather Newman</b>
17. What was her job?	<b>Cranham Feast President</b>
<b>Follow the footpath in a South Westerly direction until you come to the road. Turn left and walk down the road to the gate on your right.</b>	
18. Who made the gate?	<b>G.L.C. &amp; R. Williams</b>
<b>Return to the road and continue going down. At the bend you will see a footpath straight ahead, follow that.</b>	
19. What does the gate have scribed into it?	<b>Cranham Common</b>
20. <b>Follow the path and take the right fork up.</b> How many wooden fence posts are there on your left along this path?	<b>36</b>
21. <b>Follow the driveway out to the road with the park on your right.</b> Who installed the two benches in the playground?	<b>Cranham PC (Parish Council) 2002</b>
<b>Leave the park the same way you entered and cross the road to the grass driveway, follow and go into the graveyard. Find the grave stone with the Scout Crest on (5 rows back). <u>PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL AND QUIET WHEN IN THE GRAVEYARD and be careful where you walk.</u></b>	
22. Who was buried here?	<b>Joseph Samuel Lewis</b>
23. What was his job?	<b>Warden for the County Scout HQ 1963 – 1985</b>
24. What was his wife's name?	<b>Ida Lewis</b>
<b>Head around to the front of the church.</b>	
25. Why was the main gate built?	<b>In thanksgiving for victory of the war 1914-18 and in memory of those who died</b>
26. How many people from Cranham died and survived World War One?	<b>7 Cranham, 5 Prinknash died. 50 survived</b>
27. What is the full name of the church?	<b>St James the Great</b>
<b>Facing away from the Church, turn right and head towards the School.</b>	
28. How many yards is there no footway for?	<b>200 yards</b>
29. If you were a visitor to the school where would you sign in?	<b>The office in the school house</b>
30. What is the full name of the school?	<b>Cranham Church of England (VA) Primary School</b>
<b>Leaving the school, follow the footpath that runs to the left of the road and the grass.</b>	
31. When the footpath joins with a gravel track, there is a sign for the direction of the path you are heading, what is the name of the way?	<b>Gustav Holst Way</b>
32. When was the Cranham Common Trust fencing built?	<b>October 2011</b>
33. What colour is the horse at the pub?	<b>Black</b>
34. What is the cottage by the pub called - named after an ancient craft that Cranham Scout Centre was once used for.	<b>Pottery Cottage</b>
<b>Go down the hill and turn left and you will see the campsite sign.</b>
