Any rifle over 12 ft-lbs will not be brought on site unless declared with proof of a valid FAC and prior written approval by the Cranham Scout Centre Operations Manager.

Legal & Safety Compliance (UK law – England & Wales)



All shooting will take place only within the designated range area authorised by Cranham Scout Centre for the event.

Transport: All air rifles will arrive unloaded and in a case/cover with a valid reason for transport (attendance at the booked activity).

Secure storage: While on site, rifles will be stored unloaded, out of sight, and separately from ammunition in a locked cupboard/hard case, or secured to the building fabric with an appropriate device and keys will be stored securely separately.

Under-18 access: Reasonable precautions will be taken so that no person under 18 can gain unsupervised access to any air rifle or ammunition.

Staffing & Qualifications:

Scouts POR / Shooting Guidance (FS120004) – On-Site Requirements
Qualified supervision. The range will be operated by appropriately qualified personnel (e.g., NRA/NSRA Range Safety Officer and NRA/NSRA Rifle Instructor) and in accordance with recognised safe practice. (Attach copies or show on arrival)

Safety briefing & conduct: All participants will complete a range safety briefing, wear required PPE, follow range commands, and handle rifles only when instructed.

Parental permission: Written parental/guardian consent will be obtained for each young person prior to handling or firing an air rifle (attach your section's consent forms).

Participant Age & Supervision (England & Wales)

Under 14s: may only shoot under supervision by an adult 21+ on private premises with permission.

Risk Controls: Designated firing points, down-range danger area, and clearly marked boundaries.

Safe backstop/pellet catcher sized and positioned for calibre/velocity; checks before each session. Cease-fire and emergency procedures briefed; first-aid kit available and any incidents recorded.
